Gowanus Spring Weekend Oil Workshop 2015

TWO SESSIONS: \$300

Saturday and Sunday, Mar 14th and 15th

Class meets at 543 Union St. 4A, 9am to 5pm. Class size strictly limited to 8.

This workshop will be based on oil techniques, both for beginners and advanced students. Students will set up a palette, medium and work from still life or the Gowanus,, depending on weather, using panels or canvas. Different techniques and materials will be examined, with a view to developing a personal vision. Students will receive individual attention and instruction, as well as group critiques each session. There will be a brief demonstration for those who are unfamiliar with the medium. Students should bring any other work they might like to get input on. Collage is also an option on the Sunday.

Elizabeth O'Reilly exhibits in New York and internationally. Her paintings are included in museums, corporate and private collections. Her teaching credits include The National Academy, Parsons School of Design and Pratt Institute. She exhibits regularly at The George Billis Gallery in Chelsea, NYC, and her work can be found in numerous public and private collections including The State Department in Washington DC, The Office of Public Works, Ireland, and the Memphis Brooks Museum, Memphis, Tennessee.
